Young Civil Engineer of the Year Award

This award is to recognize the younger members of the Branch for their continuing and active service to the branch and the profession. The person, or persons nominated should be active members of the ASCE Southeast Branch of the Michigan Section and meet the guidelines listed below:

- An individual or group of individuals may submit nominations. All candidates must be nominated through the ASCE SE Branch.
- Information that is provided should be as complete and accurate as possible. This information should be descriptive of the professional service and the service to the Southeast Branch activities that the member has completed.
- The candidate civil engineer must be living at the time of his/her nomination and should be an active member of the Southeast Branch of the Michigan Section to be eligible for the award.
- A civil engineer who has moved out of state (or the country) may still be nominated for service during his/her residency in the Southeast Branch.
- Active members of the Board of Directors and/or the Award Committee shall not be eligible for the award if competing candidates' participating years in ASCE exceed those of the member candidate. Members shall automatically be eligible if no competing award candidates are submitted for consideration.
- The candidate shall be 35 years of age or less as of the date of the State Section Meeting (May 10, 2012)
- A color slide or .jpg computer file of each nominee would be appreciated for use at the awards dinner press release.
