I-75 Ambassador Bridge Gateway Project

The I-75 Ambassador Bridge Gateway Project is a major economic development project connecting area freeways to the Ambassador Bridge and Detroit's Mexicantown neighborhood. It includes reconstructed freeways and a new interchange for I-75 and I-96, a pedestrian bridge connecting east and west Mexicantown, and a redesigned Ambassador Bridge Plaza. As part of phase 4 of the Gateway Project, which includes all of the major freeway, interchange, and ramp work, a variety of traffic mitigation scenarios are either planned and underway, including the first use of High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lanes in the State of Michigan.

An overview of the Gateway project, including details of some of the traffic mitigation strategies, will be presented.
